ORDINANCE 2020 -004

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY CANCEL KERSHAW TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF OUR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS.

WHEREAS, due to the current South Carolina State of Emergency, concerns regarding COVID-19, and the impact it is having in the United States and global communities; and

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws Title 5-7-250 subsection (d) allows for Town Council to enact an emergency ordinance effective immediately to meet public emergencies affecting life, health, safety or property of the people; and

WHEREAS, given the potential devastation this pandemic can cause on our community along with priority of the Town of Kershaw places on the health, safety, and welfare of our residents and visitors; and,

WHEREAS, the Town’s Council meetings attract residents and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kershaw has decided to take precautionary measures to prevent the continued spread of this virus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kershaw, Lancaster County, South Carolina, duly assembled, do hereby:


Temporarily suspend the future Council Meetings for the Town of Kershaw until such time as the State of Emergency has been lifted by the Governor of the State of South Carolina.

Enacted this 16th day of March 2020, by a minimum of two-thirds vote of the duly elected Town Council of the Town of Kershaw, South Carolina.


