**ORDINANCE 2020 -003**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE ALL PUBIC PARKS AND FACILITIES TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF OUR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS.**

**WHEREAS**, due to the current South Carolina State of Emergency, concerns regarding COVID-19, and the impact it is having in the United States and global communities; and

**WHEREAS**, South Carolina Code of Laws Title 5-7-250 subsection (d) allows for Town Council to enact an emergency ordinance effective immediately to meet public emergencies affecting life, health, safety or property of the people; and

**WHEREAS**, given the potential devastation this pandemic can cause on our community along with priority of the Town of Kershaw places on the health, safety, and welfare of our residents and visitors; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town’s parks and facilities are a great attraction to residents and visitors alike; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kershaw has decided to take precautionary measures to prevent the continued spread of this virus.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kershaw, Lancaster County, South Carolina, duly assembled, do herby:

Temporarily suspend the use of all Town parks and facilities. Parks and facilities shall be closed immediately and until further notice at such time as the State of Emergency has been lifted by the Governor of the State of South Carolina.

**Enacted this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 2020, by a minimum of two-thirds vote of the duly elected Town Council of the Town of Kershaw, South Carolina.**



