Town of Kershaw *

An Ordinance To Increase the compensation of the Mayor and Town Council beginning on January 1, 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town Of Kershaw, in lawful assembly, that:

Section 1. Chapter 2 Administration Section 2-33. Compensation for the Mayor and Town Council Members

By Town of Kershaw Code of Ordinances Section 2-33 (b) Increases in compensation shall not be effective until the commencement date of the terms of two or more councilmembers elected at the next general election following the adoption of the ordinance, at which time it will become effective for all members.

Section 2. Reason for the increase in Compensation of Mayor and Town Council Members

The Compensation for the Mayor and Town Council Members has not been increased since 2010. The Mayor's compensation is \$5,400 per year and the Council members compensation is \$2,800 per year.

Section 3. Increased Compensation for Mayor and Town Councilmembers

Beginning January 1, 2022, the compensation for the Mayor will be \$8,100.00 per year. Beginning January 1, 2022, the compensation for Councilmembers will be \$4,500.00 per year.

Section 4. Conflicting Ordinances

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. Severability

Any chapter, article, section or subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 6. Implementation

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon its final adoption.




