  - B. **Administrator Report-** Still working on the best way to notify businesses and residential customers of emergencies within the town limits. For informational purposes only, there is a zoning change request for Gold Mine Hwy to have a 90 slot RV trailer park, on the North East of town. This is in LCWSD. Town hall will reopen on April 6,2021. The next council meeting will not be virtual, and 50% capacity, the following month we will up it to 75% capacity. The Gold Mine Cruisers will have their first car show on Saturday April 10, 2021. In the past the town has sponsored this event by providing two meal vouchers for each vehicle participate.

Would like to know if they could use Kershaw Cemetery with an additional graves they find to give the individual a proper burial.
