**B. Administrator's Report-** The weir in the basin at the WWTP is in need of immediate repair. The cost for a new weir is \$42,618.91.  
The seniors with the Lancaster County Council of Aging will begin returning to the Marion Boan Community Center on January 10, 2022.

All contracts and documents have been signed for the RIA 8" water line replacement project. Dawn Development has ordered materials. Hopes to start construction some time in January.
