Town of Kershaw *

An Ordinance to remove certain property from the Town Limits of Kershaw.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kershaw, in lawful assembly, that:

Section 1. Authorization for the De-annexation Specific Real Property Belonging to the Town of Kershaw.

The Council has determined that the real property listed below by parcel ID be listed as property that should be removed from the Town Limits

Section 2. Parcel Numbers and description of the Specific Property

Parcels Number 0155-00-023.00 & 0142.00-134.00 (Kershaw Commerce Park)
122 Acres located on North Matson and Highway 521.

Section 3. Method of de-annexation

Council Must Vote to de-annex the above property in a Council Meeting during Open Session.

Section 4. Conflicting Ordinances

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. Severability

Any chapter, article, section or subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.


Section 6. Implementation

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon its final adoption.




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
