Second Annual Golden Egg Hunt Planned

The Town of Kershaw and OceanaGold are sponsoring the second annual "Golden Egg Hunt" this Easter season. Beginning April 1, six golden eggs will be hidden within the town on public property. Each egg will contain instructions to claim a gift certificate to the local business of your choice with the grand prize egg worth a \$100 gift certificate.

If all eggs are not found by April 14, clues will be posted on the Town's Facebook page and at Town Hall. Eggs must be turned in at Town Hall by Tuesday, April 22, at 5 PM to claim prizes. Note that all eggs are hidden outdoors on public property and are five feet or less from the ground. No eggs are in restricted areas or where fees are required to enter, such as the golf course.

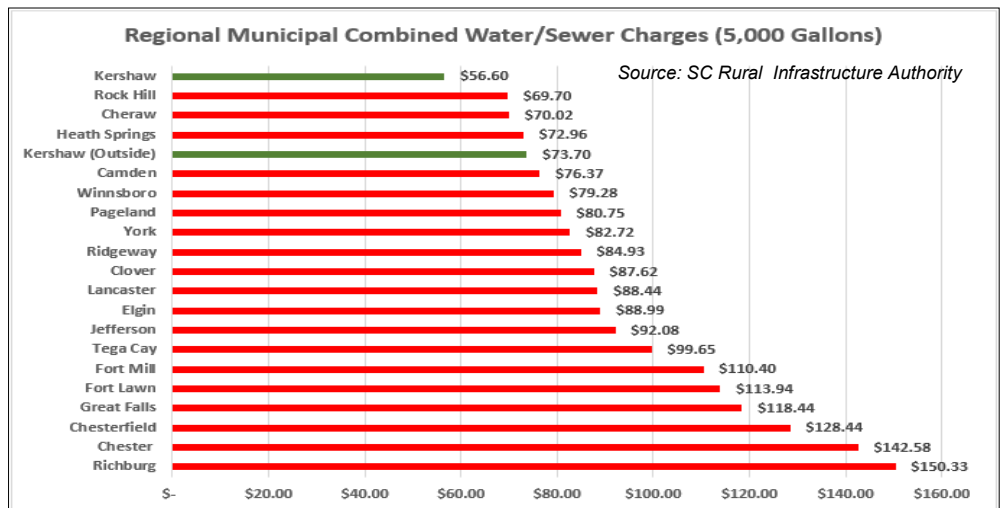


Kershaw's Water/Sewer Charges Remain Region's Lowest

Based on data from the SC Rural Infrastructure Authority in-town Kershaw customers continue to enjoy the lowest combined water and sewer charges among the 20 municipal systems providing both services in Lancaster and surrounding counties. Kershaw's average charge of \$56.60 is 40% less than the regional average charge of \$94.71.

Out-of-town Kershaw customers pay less than the in-town charges in 16 of the municipalities.

The authority's comparison is based on 5,000 gallons of monthly residential consumption.
